This class will take a "boots on the ground" look at tactics utilized by LAPD Metro Division, SWAT, and K9 during high-risk urban search operations. The concepts provided will empower Police Supervisors, Patrol Officers, SWAT and K9 Handlers in their field operations and abilities.

Perimeter and Command Post Operations – This class will explore the tactics utilized for proper containment of suspects during police operations. Topics covered will include Command Post Operations during tactical incidents, placement of command post, communications, logistics, resources, and all ancillary functions.

Search Team Tactics with SWAT and K9 - Utilizing the Police Service Dog (PSD) during search operations requires specific tactics and training, not only for officer safety, but for the successful capture of concealed suspects. Topics covered will include policies and the roll of the police service dog, proper placement of personnel, search team assignments, and directing and controlling K9.

Maneuvering in Time – The importance of time in the planning and execution of tactical operations cannot be overstated. Topics covered will include critical factors for maneuvering in time, out of the box thinking, OODA Loop, and intuitive competence.

Operations – This class will present a time-honored method for conducting an operational analysis. Topics covered will include the differences between a unified and joint command, comparison of concepts such as command, control, and management, role of the commander, his command relationships, his ability to provide direction, and a method for analyzing the "battlespace."

Planning and Decision Making – This class begins by examining the tactical planning process. Topics covered will include concepts such as Operation and Analysis, Concept of Operations and Commander's Intent, three methods for implementing a plan, three types of plans, five components of every plan, control measures such as decision points, trip wires, and rules of engagement will be defined.

Sgt. Doug Roller is the Chief Trainer for the Los Angeles Police Dept. K9 Platoon, Metro Division. He has 30 years of service which includes time with Vice, CRASH, and Complaint Investigation. He is a nationally recognized expert in perimeter containment, search techniques, and K9 tactics.

Sgt. Tim Anderson retired from the Los Angeles Police Dept. He has 28 years of service including time with SWAT, In-Service Tactics, Anti-Terrorism, CRASH, Dive Unit, and K9 supervisor. He is a retired United States Marine Corps Reserve Colonel with extensive training including USMC Amphibious Warfare School.

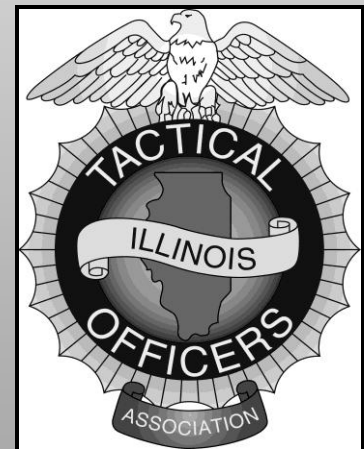
