In the early afternoon of October 23, 2004, Jeffery Arthur took his girlfriend and her brother hostage; at his home in Burnham, IL. After a short while, Jeffery Arthur released the brother but continued to hold his girlfriend hostage. Upon the brother's release, the Burnham Police Department was contacted, who in turn activated the South Suburban Emergency Response Team. SSERT negotiated with Arthur for more than seven hours, but to no avail. It was during this time, that Arthur took the opportunity to fire at team members; on two separate occasions. At approximately 9:15 PM, Arthur, with no warning; emerged from the front door of his house and stepped out onto his front porch. Using his girlfriend as a human shield, he held a pistol to her head with one hand, while choking her with the other. He initiated a count down, all the while yelling that he was going to kill her. At that point, a sniper from SSERT fired a shot killing Arthur and saving the hostage.
